- ☐ Sun hat or visor
- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ Beach or pool bag
- ☐ Reusable water bottle

DAYTIME CLOTHING

- ☐ Lightweight tops
- ☐ Shorts, skirts, or casual dresses
- ☐ Comfortable walking clothes
- ☐ Undergarments
- ☐ Sleepwear
- ☐ Light sweater or layer for air-conditioned spaces

EXCURSION CLOTHING

- ☐ Comfortable walking shoes
- ☐ Activity-specific clothing
- ☐ Water shoes when useful
- ☐ Rain layer or compact poncho
- ☐ Secure day bag or backpack
- ☐ Extra change of clothes when needed

EVENING & DINING

- ☐ Casual evening outfits
- ☐ Resort-evening or dressier outfits
- ☐ Collared shirt or dress shirt when appropriate
- ☐ Dress, skirt, trousers, or coordinated separates
- ☐ Dressier sandals or shoes
- ☐ Light wrap, sweater, or jacket

ACCESSORIES

- ☐ Small evening bag or wallet
- ☐ Belt, jewelry, scarf, or other accessories
- ☐ Hair accessories
- ☐ Waterproof phone pouch
- ☐ Laundry or wet-clothing bag

Some restaurants or evening venues may have specific clothing or footwear expectations. Review the resort's current guidance before departure so you do not discover after arrival that you left an appropriate outfit or pair of shoes at home.

- ☐ Hair-care and grooming products

- ☐ Glasses, contacts, and cleaning supplies
- ☐ Travel-size laundry or stain treatment

SUN & HEALTH

- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Lip balm with sun protection
- ☐ Aloe or after-sun care
- ☐ Prescription medications
- ☐ Basic first-aid items
- ☐ Personal over-the-counter medications
- ☐ Insect repellent when appropriate

ELECTRONICS

- ☐ Mobile phone and charger
- ☐ Portable battery pack
- ☐ Headphones or earbuds
- ☐ Camera and accessories
- ☐ Charging cables
- ☐ Travel adapter if destination requires one

MONEY & VALUABLES

- ☐ Primary payment card
- ☐ Backup payment card
- ☐ Small amount of cash or destination currency
- ☐ Secure wallet or travel pouch
- ☐ Jewelry limited to what you plan to wear
- ☐ Important valuables assigned to carry-on

CARRY-ON ESSENTIALS

- ☐ Prescription medications
- ☐ Passport and travel documents
- ☐ Swimsuit
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Change of clothing
- ☐ Phone, charger, and valuables

RESORT READY

BEFORE YOU ZIP THE SUITCASE

- ☐ Resort weather checked
- ☐ Resort dress codes reviewed
- ☐ Excursion plans reviewed
- ☐ Baggage allowance checked
- ☐ Liquids and carry-on items packed appropriately
- ☐ Chargers and travel adapters packed

BEFORE LEAVING HOME

- ☐ Airline check-in completed when available
- ☐ Airport transportation confirmed
- ☐ Passports and wallet physically checked
- ☐ Medications placed in carry-on
- ☐ Phones and portable batteries charged
- ☐ Home, pets, mail, and deliveries arranged

OUR FAMILY TRAVEL TIP

Do not pack for every possible situation. Start with your actual itinerary: beach time, pool time, restaurants, excursions, evenings, and travel days. Packing for the experiences you already plan to have usually means a lighter suitcase and fewer items you never use.
